



The LIVE Today Foundation is a 501c3 nonprofit organization whose mission is to provide FREE COMPRESSION GARMENTS to patients and survivors with lymphedema.

Dr. Sheri launched the LIVE Today Foundation to respond to the post-operative needs of breast cancer patients and survivors. 40% of the 3 million breast cancer survivors living in the US suffer with lymphedema, and that number is higher in minority and under-resourced communities where there is more need and less ability to pay for treatment.

Dr. Sheri Prentiss is a doctor and a breast cancer survivor. She understands the impact a cancer diagnosis has on someone's life. After her treatment for breast cancer, Dr. Sheri developed lymphedema in her right arm, hand, and fingers. Due to the lymphedema, she could no longer do her job as a doctor, a career she wanted since she was two years old. Dr. Sheri reinvented herself and started the LIVE Today Foundation to help other breast cancer patients and survivors like herself.
